The Great Commission

Matthew 28:18-20 NIV

18 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Therefore go and make disciples of **all nations**, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

Nations - **A collective group of people with a common bond.**

Unhealthy Commandment

What you do is more important than who you are.

But who you are is more important than what you do. Why? Mostly because the love of Jesus is in you. It's the greatest gift you have to give others.

Goal is to be like Jesus, not to know more about Jesus. The second affects the first but the second is not the goal

The truth journey to becoming a disciple

1. **Creation to The Gospel:** What is made available to us
2. **Identity:** Who is God, and who are we to him?
3. **Relationship:** What does a healthy father-child relationship look like?
4. **To be transformed by him:** To what level of freedom do you believe for?
5. **To be led by him:** To be his hands and feet.

- Speak authentically & vulnerably
- Model the life of Jesus
- Point others to Jesus

Our Role
